The **Pheasant Creek Homeowners Associations** Board of Directors has elected to change the pool identification system to a **PHOTO INDENTIFICATION TAG.** The new tags issued will be good for the next three years provided that the tags are verified each year to assure that the resident is still living in **Pheasant Creek** and that the annual assessments are paid for each subsequent year. The tags will have to be updated after the third year.

- 1. Please complete the attached form and return it to the address listed above with individual photos that are small enough to fit on the back of a business size card. **These photos will not be returned.** If you have a group photo that can be cut out and clearly denotes which individual is which, then these can be used. Note on the back of the picture the name of each individual for proper identification. Submit pictures for children 10 years and older. Younger children will be named on the parents pool pass.
- 2. The photo identification card will be made and placed in a rolodex and remain at the pool under the street address.
- 3. A responsible adult of the household must sign the pool rules acknowledgement.
- 4. Renters must include a copy of a utility bill and driver's license showing that they are living in the residence.
- 5. All maintenance fees, penalties & interest, collection cost and legal fees must be paid in order to obtain a pool I.D. Renters should contact the responsible parties to determine if the Annual fees have been paid.

ANY PREXISITING MEDICAL CONDITION THAT MAY AFFECT A SWIMMER'S ABILITY, MUST BE REPORTED AT THE GATE PRIOR TO ADMITTANCE.

- 1. Homeowners Association members only can use pool or recreation area. Guests must be accompanied by a Homeowner or a Homeowner Association Member 18 years or older. Four (4) guest limit at the discretion of lifeguard. Guest may not be a resident of the Subdivision. Non-resident guest will be charged \$2.00 per a day. All Owners must have a pool tag to enter the pool area. Tags must be worn or carried to the pool. Pool tags are only valid for the person they are assigned to. Loaned or stolen tags will be confiscated.
- 2. **Children 10 and under must be accompanied by an adult.** No pool tag is required. Children 10 years old may swim with out an adult with swim test must have a pool tag to be allowed without parents.
- 3. The Baby Pool is to be used for swimmers 5 years and under. Children in the Baby Pool will not be left unattended by an adult.
- 4. Infants must wear a Little Swimmer Pants manufactured by Huggies or an equivalent.
- 5. Adults only (18 years and older) may swim during the 10 minute break each hour. Infants and toddlers are not permitted in the pool during adult swim.
- 6. Three (3) loud, short, whistle blasts means to clear the pool.
- 7. No obnoxious Behavior:
 - a. Roughhousing, running, pushing, or riding on shoulders.
 - b. Loud, abusive or foul language.
 - Violators will be suspended for up to two (2) days.
 - c. Sound equipment allowed with headsets only.
 - d. Only in the event of an emergency may residents have any physical contact with the lifeguards.
 - e. Excessive communication with the lifeguards is distracting and dangerous.
 - Limit communication to necessary questions and comments.
- 8. Flotation devices are allowed at the discretion of the lifeguard or gate guard. No flotation devices are allowed on the diving board.
- 9. No diving in shallow end.
- 10. Only one (1) person on diving board at one time.
- 11. No glass containers in recreation and pool areas.
- 12. No cigarettes, gum, chewing tobacco, or snuff within 5 feet of pool or rest rooms. None of the above permitted on recreation or pool area by minors.

- 13. No food allowed in pool area. No alcoholic beverages allowed.
- 14. **Commercial suntan lotions only.** (no baby oil, coconut oil, or cooking oil in the pool.)
- 15. Repeat violators of any pool rule will be turned over to the Pool Committee and may result in revocation of pool privileges. Majority board vote can suspend pool privileges for up to sixty (60) days.
- 16. Swim suits only (no short pants, solid white tee shirts only permitted for sun protection.)
- 17. No pets are permitted on the pool premises.
- 18. <u>Lifeguards have the ultimate authority to enforce the pool rules.</u>
- 19. The pool phone is <u>only</u> for use by pool or gate guards.
- 20. In the event of poor weather or over crowding, the pool area will be closed and both gates locked.
- 21. The Lifeguard, Gate Guard, or any Pheasant Creek Board Member may suspend anyone disobeying the rules or endangering the safety of others for up to two (2) days.

To be eligible to use the pool, residents must be current on their Annual Assessment fees and must comply with the Pool Rules. Residents are responsible for their guests and must supervise them at all times. These rules are for your own safety and the safety of other residents and guests. All residents (adults & children) and guests must comply with these rules or they will be asked to leave the pool. Failure to leave when asked will result in two (2) additional days of suspension. Attempting to use the pool during a suspension will result in an additional two (2) days of suspension.
