

GENERAL POOL RULES

Foxwood Subdivision – Section 1 – 4

POOL PASSES

1. You cannot swim without a current year pool pass or be the invited guest of a resident with a current year pool pass. See guest policy below.
2. Only residents of Foxwood Sections 1 – 4 are eligible to apply for a pass.
3. No one will be admitted without proper ID.

AROUND THE POOL AREA CONDUCT

1. No running or rough play (such as throwing someone into the pool, pushing, dunking, water fights) are allowed.
2. No pets are permitted in the Pool or Pool area.
3. Swimmers under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult (in the pool area) at all times, no exception.
4. Obey Life guards and other supervisory personnel.
5. Be alert to anyone in trouble.
 - a. Call for help immediately.
 - b. Do not move, or remove from the water, an injured person who has complained of back or neck injuries.

LIFEGUARDS

1. Lifeguards have the ultimate authority in and around the pool area, the pavilion and the restroom/ shower area.
2. Lifeguards are employed to ensure the safety of the swimmers.

3. Lifeguards have the authority to:
 - a. Remove anyone from the pool area who will not obey the rules.
 - b. Remove anyone from the pool area who acts in a way that endangers him/herself or others.
 - c. Suspend the offender for one day.
 - d. Report repeat offenders to the pool committee, who has the authority to revoke swimming privileges for the remainder on the swimming season.

CLOTHING AND SUN BLOCK

1. Proper swimming attire is required.
 - a. Only regulation swimming attire specifically designed are allowe manufactured for swimming/pool use is permitted.
 - b. No blue jean cut offs are permitted.
 - c. No leggings are permitted.
 - d. Only white t-shirts are allowed. No colored t-shirts or white t-shirts with printed logos are allowed. The dyes and other chemicals used in general clothing manufacturing can cause damage to the pool filtration system. The same dyes can affect the PH of the water. They are not safe.
 - e. Swimsuits are required in the Baby Pool.
 - i. No disposable diapers are allowed in the baby pool.
 - ii. "Little Swimmers" or other diapers manufactured for use in the pool are allowed.
2. The use of sun block and other lotions are not permitted.
 - a. Sun tan lotion, sun block, baby oil. Coconut oil and other similar types of lotions cause equipment damage.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE CONSUMPTION

1. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the Pool or Park area at any time.
2. No glass containers are allowed in the Pool area.
3. No smoking anywhere in the Pool area, including the pavilion.
4. Chewing gum while swimming is not allowed.
5. Water, soft drinks and juice boxes are allowed in the Pavilion only.
6. No food of any kind is to be brought into the pool or pavilion areas. Only exception is a Foxwood HOA sponsored event.

GUEST POLICY

1. Each resident with a current, valid pool pass is permitted one (1) guest per day. There is no charge for the guest.
2. Guests may only be in the pool area as long as the resident that brought them is also in the pool area.
3. Guests must sign-in with the lifeguard:
 - a. Guest will be given a wristband by the lifeguards.
 - b. The wristband must be worn the entire time they are in the pool area and must be returned to the lifeguards when leaving the pool area.
4. The sponsoring resident is responsible for the guest's behavior at all times.
5. Guests are subject to all pool rules. Failure to follow the rules will result in the loss of swimming privileges, and the guest will be required to leave the pool area.

SWIMMING and DIVING

The Diving Board has been removed due to safety issues. The diving board will not be replaced.

1. No diving in the shallow end of the pool (less than 6 feet).
2. Diving from the side of the pool (deep-end only) is allowed.
3. Flips from the side of the pool are not allowed at any time.
4. Swimmers in the water have the right-of-way. Divers must be sure that there are no swimmers or floaters in the way before diving into the pool.
5. Divers must be able to swim the length of the pool in a reasonably safe manner without stopping.
6. Children under the age of 10 may dive with a parent/chaperone close by.
7. Divers may not wear flotation devices, goggles, fins or masks when diving.
